I am in the process of notifying people of our intention to sell Reg's Place Pottery School. I have been running the school for six years and found the decision a difficult one. I am hoping to sell the school as it stands - a small six wheel school with a hobby studio and 3-4 resident potters.

It has served as a studio for hobbyists to continue their work with pottery ~~at~~ without having to set up their own studio - which is usually unsuccessful for them.

I am selling because I wish to start working full-time in a studio situation with a gas kiln, either on my own or with a group, in September. Probably having to find pottery work elsewhere.

Meanwhile Karen Yule is managing Reg's Place this spring, as I am working at Tazart - using her space. She will be running Spring classes + workshops.
