It was great fun to see you again. Everyone enjoyed  
meeting you - you left a good impression.

I have enclosed a cheque in the amount of \$~~344~~.25 for  
your expenses and a copy of the invoice sent to Denys,  
Hiro and Sally. It certainly makes it easier to do  
things on a cost-sharing basis.

We are very busy with Granville Island. We will sign  
a three year lease at \$300 a month. Beautifully subsidized  
by Central Mortgage and Housing. Tom Fielding, Cultural  
Services Director (our funder) is only too happy to fund  
the Gallery on an independant basis. He said that the  
Association is a "service" organization and the gallery  
although closely affiliated *has a separate* function.  
Our grant application to Explorations/CC for the Resource  
Centre has gone in, we will submit for enviornmental and  
display equipment to the National Museums, to the provincial  
Lottery Fund under Special Grants and the Vancouver Foundation  
for capital costs and anywhere else that we can solicit  
free materials. We have had an architect look at the space  
and the formal proposal for the project will be made to the  
CABC board at our April 9th meeting for the go ahead. The  
project office on the Island hopes to be out by the end of  
May. So all things being equal we should be open for business  
by September at the latest. "The best laid plans of men and  
mice".
